## MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

After two years of concerted development activities and events, and the generosity of over 200 members and donors the Trust continues to move towards sustainability. Several accomplishments during the past year include the following.

### *Acquisitions*

During the 2009-2010 fiscal year the Trust was able to purchase 14 acres adjacent to the north edge of the Nehalem Estuary in the Bayside Gardens neighborhood. Approximately nine acres are wetlands with a small creek flowing through the western portion of the wetlands. The other five acres are mostly uplands with one boundary contiguous to the north east corner of Nehalem Bay State Park. The Board has named these properties Cedar Creek.

### *New Board Member.*

### *Nehalem Teaching Trail.*

A Trust project currently under development is the Nehalem Teaching Trail, a native plant habitat pathway that will wind through the entrance area of Alder Creek Farm. The Trail will connect five stations each highlighting a specific Nehalem river basin habitat, which focus on those of the local estuary, riparian, and upland habitats. They will have identifying signage that describes the traditional gathering and use of plants by the Nehalem people for food, shelter, clothing, medicine, and ceremony; and, will emphasize methods and rationale for sustainable harvesting. The Nehalem Teaching Trail will engage and inform visitors and students in a creative venue that facilitates an appreciation of our coastal environment as well as the complexity of local native cultures.

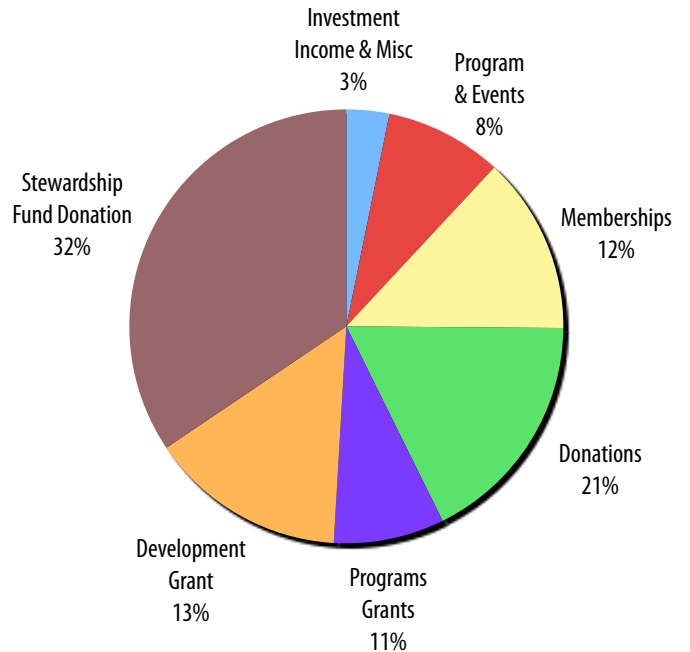

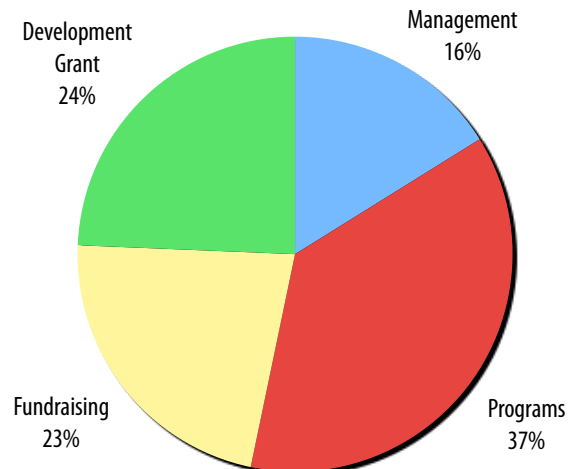

- Barn repair at Alder Creek Farm completed using timber-frame construction methods
